

7.30 (1) \* Ordinance establishing split shifts for election officials.

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Colburn, Chippewa County

The Town Board of the Town of Colburn, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 [ or more] sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

A. There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 7 a.m. and end at 12 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 12 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
